Points to Ponder:

1. Consider what the angel Gabriel says to Mary: “Nothing will be impossible with God.” God did the impossible by becoming man. Praise God throughout this week as you consider how He accomplished the impossible by being born of a virgin so that through the birth of the baby born in a manger salvation was made possible.
2. Consider the faith of Mary this week. What does Mary’s faith teach you about taking God at His word even if you do not understand how things may work out? Ask God to grow your faith in Him.
3. Consider how Mary says nothing about the soon to come shame that she would endure because of a premarital pregnancy but fully submits to God’s plan as a willing servant. Are you more like a willing servant or a reluctant slave? Ask the Lord to turn your heart into a willing servant’s heart.
